Vigilance plays a significant role in keeping our students safe. Parents, students, school staff, and community members are encouraged to immediately report student safety concerns through the Camden County School “Care” hotline.... The “Care” hotline is available 24 hours a day to report student incidents such as those involving weapons, drugs, self-harm, physical threats to others, and cyberbullying/bullying.

If you learn of a potentially dangerous situation, immediately call 1-833-300STOP or email tipline@securly.com to report student safety concerns. Please provide the name of the school and/or student(s) involved, type of alleged activities, and when they occurred or may occur.

Situations requiring an immediate response or intervention should be directed to 911.
